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


AUTHOR

He was also editor-in-chief of the "Books" department (2006-2008) then a columnist (2008-2015) at L'Express, producer of the daily Le Grand Entretien on France Inter (national radio) between 2010 and 2013, editorial director of Lire magazine between 2004 and 2015, and founder and editorial director of the mook America between 2017 and 2021.

Henri Rivière, a lover of Japanese prints, was inspired by the most famous of Japanese painters, Hokusai, who had painted, between 1831 and 1833, The 36 Views of Mount Fuji. Inspired by these two artists, and at the request of the famous gallery owner Christian Desbois, the renowned comic book artist André Juillard published his 36 Views of the Eiffel Tower. This was in 2002 and for the past 20 years this art book has become rare and has acquired a cult status. Hence the idea of this 2022 new edition, entirely revisited and redesigned, in an elegant hardcover format, also featuring some unpublished works.


