And it's for anyone who senses that there must be something more—a deeper rhythm to life, a hidden current beneath the noise.**

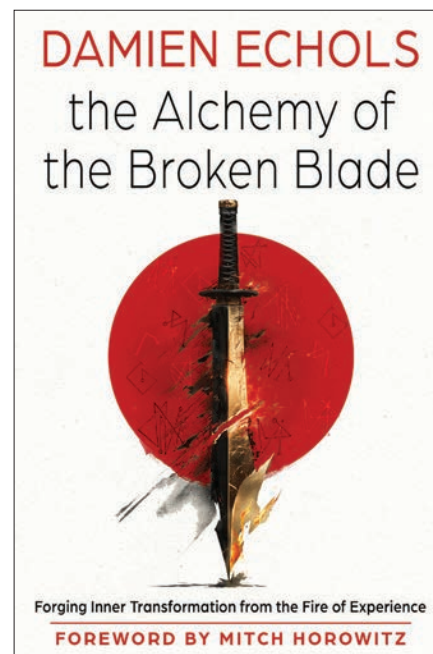
From death row, solitary confinement, spiritual breakdown, and resurrection, Echols spent years clawing his way out of despair and into a life he could stand inside again. Through that process, he discovered a path rooted in discipline, ritual, devotion, and presence.

His method is an amalgamation of Eastern (Kaizen) and Western (Hermetic) philosophies. Alchemy and Kaizen share a root principle: transformation through presence. The core concept revolves around “the Way” (do), a path of personal and lasting transformation.

“I wrote this book because I believe the way we live needs to be reimagined. Not in some utopian, idealistic way—but in a grounded, embodied way. *The Alchemy of the Broken Blade* is a call to live differently—not perfectly but purposely,” Echols explains about his forthcoming book.

The book is structured in four parts to mirror the four steps of the alchemical process:

- Part One: Deconstruction—examines breaking down the false self and recognizing internal enemies, using experiences such as solitary confinement as a metaphor for turning a tomb into a temple.
- Part Two: Reconstruction—focuses on rebuilding using tools such as magick, alchemy, Tang Soo Do, Kaizen, Bushido, and concepts like the Chil Sung (Seven Stars).
- Part Three: Integration—discusses putting knowledge into practice in daily life, making one's personal “do” a way of living.
- Part Four: Becoming—addresses the “Alchemy of Now,” focusing on embodied presence and what happens after crossing the abyss, emphasizing that the path is continuous and requires ongoing practice.

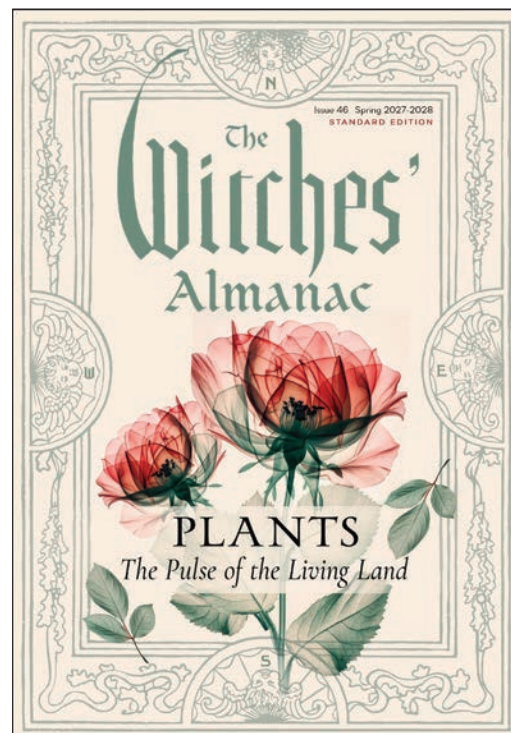
- A host of esteemed authors active in the witchcraft, Pagan, and magical communities provide in-depth information and points of view.

SETTING & DESCRIPTION

SETTING PREPARES the most overlooked aspect of the craft of writing. However, as this chapter will show, it is essentially impossible to tell any semblance of a story without some definable setting in time or place. The aim here is to help writers make even the most fantastic and abstract settings 'true' for themselves and their readers without killing off their imagination or losing sight of the plot in an excess of detail. Author and critic Carmen Maria Machado writes that plots are never just places in a piece of writing. So how do settings shape the stories told within them? What do they reveal about the characters who inhabit them? And how do they reflect or subvert the real-world environments from which they draw inspiration? This section is designed to help authors explore the ways in which settings can establish mood and tone, develop characterization, propel narrative and make your writing more immersive. We will consider 'macro' concepts about setting in place and time, examine a range of popular settings in fiction, and explore 'micro' details in describing aspects of setting through sensory and physical description. Finally, there are exercises based on discussions covered in these pages to help writers struggling with setting to experiment with fresh perspectives. Here you will also find questions to consider in embarking on world building—these should prove useful to writers developing any setting but are particularly focused on fantastic or otherworldly settings. It is my hope that readers will gain inspiration from—and a renewed appreciation for—the genius of authors who transport us to worlds both familiar and fantastical, using the power of place to illuminate the complexities of the human experience.

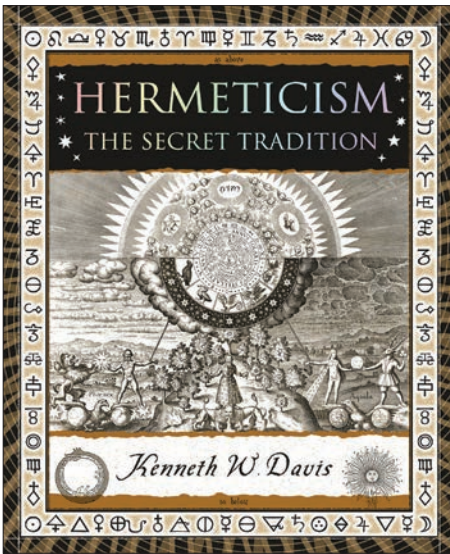

GENRE & TROPE

WHY DOES GENRE MATTER and how does it help you as a writer? Any pitch for storytelling, be it novel, film, stage, or radio, will require you to define your work by genre. This gives your audience an insight into what to expect from your piece. Certain genres go through phases of popularity. Agents and publishers were all signing horror fiction in the 1970s and 80s, and romance and young adult fiction in the 2000s. The aim of this appendix is to help writers of all mediums to understand what the characteristics of a genre are, so they can achieve success in their writing. As well as definitions and examples, we present tropes common to each genre. This is not a 'checklist' of things to include, but identifiers which might help in the categorisation process and to offer inspiration if you are still developing your work. New genres emerge within literature from time to time and I always encourage writers to know what is typical, but also to be free enough to play with rules and expectations. This is a guide, not a rulebook. Compounding genres is perfectly fine, writers do it all the time. However, it is generally wise to blend no more than two core genres in the description of your work, to ensure that your work has a clear sense of identity, and to encourage immediate recognition in your audience. This appendix uses the term 'genre' in its broad theoretical sense, but be aware that 'genre fiction' is also a book trade term, denoting works which are written in accessible styles within certain commercial categories—for example 'genre romance'. Don't worry, all will become clear over the pages which follow!
