



MISSING AND MURDERED is an unprecedented effort to detail eight unsolved cases of indigenous women who disappeared in North America. Native women face a murder rate 10 times higher than the national average. Faith Phillips, a Cherokee true crime novelist, targets eight cases of missing and murdered indigenous women that she believes are all solvable. The author, with a proven track record of reopening official cold case investigations, travels to each of the eight tribes across North America to document the crimes, share the grief of families who continue to search for their missing women, and coordinate resources between state, tribal, and federal governments to demand answers, once and for all.

Faith Phillips is a screenwriter, author, and producer. Faith is a 2026 recipient of the Foundation House Residency. She previously worked to reopen the Girl

Scout Murders cold case in Oklahoma. The result of that harrowing investigation, THE GIRL SCOUT MURDERS, is now streaming on Fox Nation. Faith's third book, a true crime novel about the notorious Weleetka murders, became the Oklahoma best seller, NOW I LAY ME DOWN, which was selected for development by Firelight Films.


Her current projects include Missing & Murdered, an unscripted series designed to help solve #MMIW cases, and the scripted crime noir thrillers, CADAVER DOG and MANKILLER SHELL, as well as a comedy travel series, LIFE ON THE RIVER. The author lives with her family on the Cherokee reservation and travels the national speaking circuit telling stories about writing and producing in Indian Country.

Bonnie-Jill is a trailblazing sports broadcaster and **the first and only female NBA scout**, holding the front office executive position with the **Los Angeles Lakers**. She's the first woman to dance at a professional level for three teams, in two sports, starting with the NBA's Golden State Warriors, and moving to the NFL for both the San Francisco 49ers and the Dallas Cowboys. She is the **first female to be awarded six championship rings in two professional sports**, earning a Super Bowl ring during her time cheering for the 49ers, and five NBA championship rings as an executive for the Lakers. She has worked as a reporter and host for ESPN, NBA TV, NBC/NBC Sports, NFL Films, Westwood One, CBS, E!, BBC Sports, SiriusXM, NFR Live, and Fox Sports, and is a host ambassador for Michael Jordan's "Jordan Brand."



The title BLOOM HOW YOU MUST comes from a Lucille Clifton poem, "Mulberry Fields," about the enduring legacy of Black People. Tara is the founder of The Self Care Suite, a wellness community for Black women and other women of color.

Self-care is now a multi-billion dollar industry, and it is not a trend or frivolous matter for Black women. It has always been a throughline: Consider Coretta Scott King on girls' trips with fellow activist Betty Shabazz and Myrlie Evers-Williams to take a break from the stress of the civil rights movement. Remember Rosa Parks attending (and leading!) yoga classes in the midst of her Detroit activism. Bloom How You Must will connect the dots in one easy to read, digestible book—part guide/part journal with exercises to put each segment of wellness into practice. Her voice has been featured on New York magazine/The Cut, Black Enterprise and Essence.
