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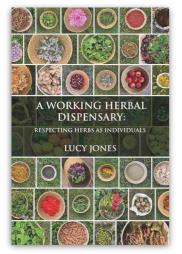
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A Working Herbal Dispensary: Respecting Herbs As Individuals

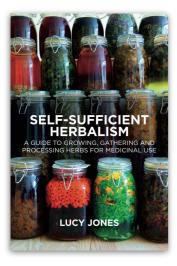
A beautifully illustrated guide on how to understand and engage with medicinal herbs.

about each herb as an individual that she knows and respects, rather than simply a list of conditions it treats or the constituents it contains. Lucy gives the physiological actions, energetic qualities and emotional resonances, as well as qualities according to Tibetan Medicine, where they apply. She also includes historical views, magical associations and plenty of recipes for the home herbal apothecary, as well as informal case studies.

A Working Herbal Dispensary is much more than a herbal; it is an insight into a holistic practice where herbs and herbalist are working in partnership for the benefit of those that need help.

LUCY JONES is a qualified medical herbalist and owner of Myrobalan Clinic, a busy high street practice in Somerset, UK. Prior to qualifying in Western herbalism, she earned two degrees from Oxford University and studied Tibetan Medicine with the great master Khenpo Troru Tsenam. When treating patients, she combines Western herbal medicine with the principles of Tibetan Medicine. She grows and processes most of her own herbs.

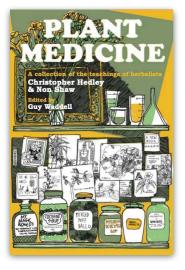

NON SHAW was a herbalist, counsellor, and bodyworker who inspired many to take up their own healing paths in plant medicine. Non was an artist, sculptor, jeweller, clothes-maker, and inveterate maker of things. She was also a teacher and writer.

GUY WADDELL is a lecturer in the Department of Life Sciences at the University of Westminster, London. His background is in social sciences and in herbal medicine. He has been a practitioner of Western herbal medicine for over 15 years, and practises in South London.

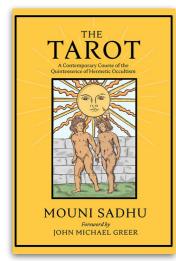
An investigation into the underpinnings and superstructures of the Pagan world view.

Pagan religions have tended to be more concerned with practice than with theory and in a system that has no dogma - no legislated doctrine - that is as it should be. Yet as this movement grows and matures, it is inevitable that we

will begin to think in a more abstract way about our models and systems. In this book, John Michael Greer has provided a primer on the kinds of ideas and themes that must be included in any discussion of the theology and philosophy of Neo-pagan religions.

Much of the book takes shape in a dialogue with existing ideas in theology, philosophy, and comparative religion. It looks to find a middle ground between too much and too little reference to the work of other scholars to find a comprehensible yet intellectually rigorous middle ground.

It aims to be part of a conversation, that stretches out over the centuries. Voices of polytheist spirituality have had little place in that conversation for many years, but much of value has been said in their absence. The rebirth of polytheism as a living religious tradition in the Western world will inevitably force a reassessment of much of that heritage, and pose challenges to some of its most cherished assumptions.



The Tarot: The Quintessence of Hermetic Philosophy By Mouni Sadhu

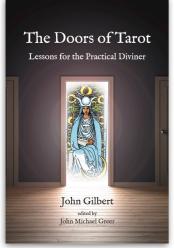

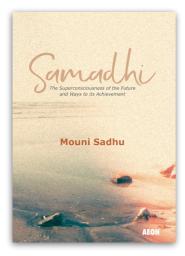
Written in a simple and easily understandable style, *Concentration* is a classic among books on the art of meditation.
